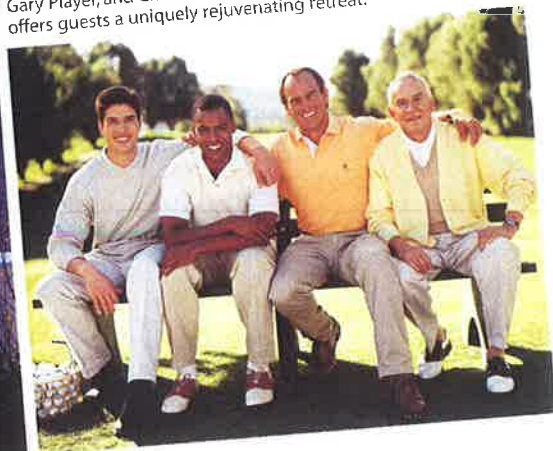

THE BROADMOOR**

Known as the *grande dame* of the Rockies, The Broadmoor is one of the country's top-rated resorts: it has earned a combined rating of AAA Five Diamonds and Mobil Five Stars a remarkable 32 years in a row. Amenities include an award-winning spa, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, three outdoor hot tubs, 54 holes of championship golf, and seven tennis courts. There are four stellar restaurants on the property (including the state's first and only Five Diamond restaurant) and cellars stocked with 75,000 bottles of vintage wine. **LOS ANGELES
OJAI VALLEY INN & SPA**

Nestled in a picturesque valley south of Santa Barbara, the town

of Ojai, with its hiking and biking trails, is a favorite getaway spot for Angelenos (although it does get significantly hotter than the city in the summertime). The Five Diamond Ojai Valley Inn and Spa is recommended by numerous spa guides, and offers 220 tree-shaded acres with luxury accommodations and a championship golf course that has hosted seven Senior PGA Tour events. BARNESLEY GARDENS RESORT**

There are a surprising number of world-class resort spas in northern Georgia; one of the closest to Atlanta is Barnesley Gardens Resort, which boasts a colorful history as well as luxurious cottages designed in the English country estate mold (each with its own English-style garden). A full range of activities is offered, including quail hunting, sporting clays, fishing, and horseback riding, as well as The General, a Jim Fazio-designed championship golf course. And then there's the full-service spa, with 10 treatment rooms, a large co-ed whirlpool, and ladies and men's grooming areas with separate saunas, steam rooms, and whirlpools.
